EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)

Food (Bacon)

ORDER, DATED MAY 12, 1942, AMENDING THE BACON (ADDITION OF BORAX) ORDER, 1940.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as amended, and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:—

The Bacon (Addition of Borax) Order, 1940, as amended^(a), shall be further amended by substituting in Article 4A of the Order for the words “ the 16th May, 1942 ”, the words “ the 16th July, 1942.”
