The Food for Particular Nutritional Uses (Miscellaneous Amendments) (England) Regulations 2010

DETAIL OF CONSULTATION

Introduction

1. Council Directive 89/398/EEC on foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses (the parnuts framework directive) has been amended by Directives 96/84/EC, 1999/41/EC and Regulation (EC) 1882/2003. In 1987, the European Commission decided that legislative measures should be codified after no more than ten amendments, and preferably at shorter intervals, to ensure that they are clear and readily understandable; therefore, in 2004 the Commission began the process of codifying Directive 89/398/EEC.
2. In 2006, Council Decision 1999/468/EC laying down procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission was amended by Decision 2006/512/EC which introduced a regulatory procedure with scrutiny for measures of general scope designed to amend non-essential elements of a basic instrument adopted in accordance with the procedure referred to in Article 251 of the Treaty. In accordance with a joint statement of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission (OJ C 255, 21.10.2006, p1), for this new procedure to be applicable to such instruments already in force, they must be amended. Therefore the codification of Directive 89/398/EEC was transformed into a recast in order to incorporate these adjustments.
3. There are no significant differences between the text of 89/398/EEC as amended and the text of 2009/39/EC other than those which introduce a regulatory procedure with scrutiny; these new provisions do not need to be transposed. However, references to Directive 89/398/EEC in domestic law do need to be replaced by references to Directive 2009/39/EC.

Proposals

1. **Do nothing**
2. **Introduce provisions into law in England so that references to Directive 89/398/EEC in existing legislation are replaced by references to Directive 2009/39/EC.**

Option 2 is preferred as this will provide clarity to all those who deal with the legislation.

To note: The Food Labelling Regulations 1996 are amended relatively often. If a statutory instrument amending those Regulations is in prospect after the end of the consultation period on this statutory instrument, a decision may be taken to incorporate the text in this statutory instrument which amends the Food Labelling Regulations 1996 into the statutory instrument amending those Regulations.

Consultation Process

1. A full 12-week public consultation is being undertaken on the draft SI and all responses received as part of this consultation will be given careful consideration. These will be summarised and published on the Agency's website in due course.

Q1: Have we captured all the references to 89/398/EC in existing legislation? If not, please tell us where others are.

Q2: Do you have other comments on the drafting of this SI? If so, please let us have them.

The Food for Particular Nutritional Uses (Miscellaneous Amendments) (England) Regulations 2010

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 17(1), 26(1)(a) and 48(1) of the Food Safety Act 1990(a) and now vested in him(b), as read with paragraph 1A of Schedule 2 to the European Communities Act 1972(c).

These Regulations make provision for a purpose mentioned in section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 and it appears to the Secretary of State that it is expedient for certain references to Directive 2009/39 of the European Parliament and of the Council on foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses(d) to be construed as references to that instrument as amended from time to time.

In accordance with section 48(4A) of the Food Safety Act 1990, the Secretary of State has had regard to relevant advice given by the Food Standards Agency.

As required by Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety(e), there has been open and transparent public consultation during the preparation and evaluation of these Regulations.

Sections 17 and 48 were amended by paragraphs 12 and 21 respectively of Schedule 5 to the Food Standards Act 1999 (1999 c.28), “the 1999 Act”. Section 48 was also amended by S.I. 2004/2990. Section 53(2) was amended by paragraph 19 of Schedule 16 to the Deregulation and Contracting Out Act 1994 (1994 c.40), Schedule 6 to the 1999 Act and S.I. 2004/2990.

Those functions, so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by S.I. 1999/672 as read with section 40(3) of the 1999 Act and thereafter transferred to the Welsh Ministers by paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (2006 c.32). Those functions, so far as exercisable in relation to Scotland, were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (1998 c.46) as read with section 40(2) of the 1999 Act.

Title, application and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Food for Particular Nutritional Uses (Miscellaneous Amendments) (England) Regulations 2010, apply in relation to England only and come into force on 15th March 2010.

Amendment of the Food Labelling Regulations 1996

2.—(1) The Food Labelling Regulations 1996(a) are amended in accordance with the following paragraphs in so far as they apply in relation to England.

(2) In paragraph (1) of regulation 2 (interpretation)—

(a) omit the definition of “Directive 89/398”;

(b) after the definition of “Directive 2000/13” insert the following definition—

““Directive 2009/39” means Directive 2009/39/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses as amended from time to time;”.

(3) In regulation 3 (exemptions), for sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (1) substitute the following sub-paragraph—

“(iv) where applicable, the requirements of Directive 87/250, Directive 90/496, Directive 94/54, Directive 99/2 and Directive 2009/39 are met in respect of that food.”.

Amendment of the Notification of Marketing of Food for Particular Nutritional Uses (England) Regulations 2007

3.—(1) The Notification of Marketing of Food for Particular Nutritional Uses (England) Regulations 2007(b) are amended in accordance with the following paragraphs.

(2) In paragraph (1) of regulation (2) (interpretation), for the definition of “the Directive” substitute the following definition—

““the Directive” means Directive 2009/39 of the European Parliament and of the Council on foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses as amended from time to time;”.

(3) In regulation 3 (restrictions on sale)—

(a) for paragraph (1) substitute the following paragraph—

“(1) No person who, in respect of a PNU food product of a particular type—

(a) is a manufacturer or an importer referred to in Article 11 of the Directive, but

(b) has failed to comply with—

(i) a requirement to notify the competent authority, as referred to in paragraph (a) or (b) of that Article, or

(ii) a requirement to produce anything to the competent authority, as referred to in paragraph (c) of that Article,

shall sell a PNU food product of that type. ”; and

(b) in sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (2) for “Article 9” substitute “Article 11”.

(4) In paragraph (1) of regulation 4 (declaration), for “Article 1(2)” substitute “Article 1(2) and (3)”.
