EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)
Food (Imported Canned Meat)

ORDER, DATED JULY 3, 1941, AMENDING THE IMPORTED CANNED MEAT (REQUISITION) ORDER, 1939.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as amended, and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Imported Canned Meat (Requisition) Order, 1939^(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order"), shall be amended as follows:—

(a) There shall be substituted for Article 1 thereof the following Article:—

" 1. In this Order:—

" Canned Meat " means any meat packed in an airtight container.

" Meat " means beef, mutton, lamb, veal, pork, edible offals, poultry, game, rabbits, venison, goats' flesh, and includes any foodstuff for human consumption which contains any meat as hereinbefore defined to an extent of not less than 25 per cent. by weight.

" Imported " means imported into the United Kingdom."

(b) There shall be inserted in Article 3 of the Principal Order after the word "Order" where it first occurs, the words "as hereby amended".

2.—(1) This Order shall come into force on the 7th day of July, 1941.

(2) Copies of the Principal Order to be printed under the authority of His Majesty's Stationery Office after the date of the coming into force of this Order shall be printed with the amendments provided for by this Order and the Principal Order shall take effect as hereby amended.
