EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)
Food (Flour)

THE FLOUR (RESTRICTION ON USE) ORDER, 1942.
DATED MARCH 11, 1942.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as amended, and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:—

1. In this Order:—

- (a) "The Minister" means the Minister of Food.
- (b) "Article of food" means any article used as food for human consumption, and includes any substance which ordinarily enters into or is used in the composition or preparation of human food, and also includes any flavouring matter or condiment.

"Flour" and "per cent. extraction" have the same meaning as in the Flour (Control and Prices) Order, 1941(a), as amended(b).

2. Except under and in accordance with the terms of a licence granted for the purposes of this Order by or on behalf of the Minister, no person shall in connection with any trade or business manufacture any article of food (other than bread) containing flour, unless at least 75 per cent. of the flour content of such article of food consists of flour of not less than 85 per cent. extraction.

3.—(1) This Order is subject to any authorisations or directions which may at any time be given by or on behalf of the Minister.

(2) Every person holding a licence or authorisation granted under this Order shall comply with every condition imposed by such licence or authorisation.

4. Infringements of this Order are offences against the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939.

5. This Order shall come into force on the 20th day of April, 1942, and may be cited as the Flour (Restriction on Use) Order, 1942.
