EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)
Food (Flour)

ORDER, DATED JULY 29, 1942, AMENDING THE FLOUR (CONTROL AND PRICES) ORDER, 1941.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as amended, and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The Flour (Control and Prices) Order, 1942, as amended(a), shall be further amended as follows:—

- (a) by inserting in the definition of "wheat by-product" appearing in paragraph (1) of Article I thereof after the words "straight run bran" the words "coarse bran, fine bran";
- (b) by substituting in the Second Column of Part I of the First Schedule thereto for the price of 43s. 6d. prescribed in respect of semolina produced in the United Kingdom, the price of 50s.;
- (c) by substituting in the First Column of Part III of the First Schedule thereto for the words "straight run bran", the words "straight run bran, coarse bran or fine bran";
- (d) by substituting in the scale of additional charges appearing in paragraphs I (1) and I (2) of Part I of the Second Schedule thereto for the additional charges of 9d. and 1s. respectively, the additional charges of 1s. and 1s. 3d. respectively;
- (e) by deleting paragraph 3 of section A of Part II of the Second Schedule thereto.

2. This Order shall come into force on the 2nd day of August, 1942.
